2025 Old Northwest Territories Primitive Rendezvous (ONW)

This year's ONW will be held June 20-27, 2025 at Hidden Hollow Camp, 8672 Richmond Rd, Lodi, OH. 44254. Hidden Hollow Camp is a beautiful site owned by the Medina County Park District near Lodi Ohio. Hidden Hollow Camp features a large pond for fishing (no license required) and nature walking paths. The NRLHF has plenty of area for shoots, archery, knife and hawk competitions.

Not pre-registered? No problem! You can still register at the gate: \$85 for members/\$95 for non-members. If you're coming prior to Friday, early set-up fees will apply at \$5.00/day additional. Make checks payable (US Funds only) to National Rendezvous and Living History Foundation.

All lodges, clothes, etc. must be in the period of 1640-1840 in North America. Non-primitive items must be out of sight at all times including cell phones (which should be on quiet ring if not muted). Long term camp and primitive pack-in trek area available. No modern camping available. See Campground Information for details on local campgrounds.

Firewood, water, hooters, and trash pick-up will be provided. Ice will be available for purchase. Dealers and possessors of furs, feathers, claws, etc. it is your responsibility to conform to city and state laws.

Artillery will be allowed. No horses/mules/oxen. No pets in the primitive area, service animals are welcome.

- Early set-up June 18 any time after 12:00pm
- General set-up June 20 after 8:00am
- Public Days: June 21 and 22 - 10:00am-4:00pm; free admission donations gladly accepted.
- Opening Ceremony June 20 at 5:00pm
- Closing Ceremony June 27 at 12:00 Noon
- All camps must be cleaned up and gone by June 27 at 6:00pm
- General set-up times are 7:00am-9:00am and 5:00pm-7:00pm. There will be an hour and a half time limit for unloading and loading vehicles.

I am asking for volunteers in all areas such as Children's games, ladies tea, range officers, gate aides. You will not be stuck at your station all day. Shifts will happen, so don't let that discourage you.

Pre-Registration Instructions and Definitions

Payment: Make checks/ money orders payable to NRLHF (US funds only) and mail to:

Forms must be filled out in BLACK or BLUE INK only. Please print legibly.

ALL Pre-Registration forms must be postmarked no later than 21 days before the start date of the Rendezvous. Forms that are postmarked after the 21st day deadline will be returned to sender.

▶ PayPal transactions must be dated 21 days before the start date of the Rendezvous. Funds will be refunded on transactions dated after the deadline. (9/2024)

The NRLHF provides a reduced rate for NMLRA members and their immediate families. Immediate family includes spouse and legal dependents. Any person expelled or denied membership in the NMLRA is excluded from the preferred rate for their selves and their family members. If more than one person/family is listed on a pre-registration form the membership number must be listed for each person/family. Participants attending a NRLHF event must show a current NMLRA membership card of a member of that family in order to obtain the reduced rate.

Participants who are not NMLRA members may attend NRLHF events and participate in all activities and competitions fully and on an even basis with NMLRA members.

ALL CHILDREN 17 AND UNDER ARE FREE

Other:

- Anyone who attends NRLHF events and are under the age of 17 MUST be accompanied by a parent or quardian. They may not camp alone.
- There is no early set up fee for participants who are pre-registered
- NO ONE, not on the Booshway staff will be permitted to set up prior to the Wednesday preceding the start of the event, with the exception of the Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer and Delegate.
- NO PETS IN THE PRIMATIVE AREA. The NRLHF follows the ADA rules and regulations. Pets in the modern area are subject to the NRLHF's nuisance rule. (9/2011)
- Traders must comply with all NRLHF trade rules. Visit our website at www.nrlhf.org for a list of the rules.
- In the event that someone does not attend the Foundation event for which he/she was preregistered, he/she may request in writing a refund of the pre-registration fees within 21 days prior to the event.
- Refund requests are to be submitted to the Business Office.
- NO refund checks will be distributed before the event.
